Dear Mr. Foxe,

I refer to the request, which you have made under the Freedom of Information Act 2014 for access to records held by this Department, as follows:

A record detailing the inventory of wine held by the Department of Foreign Affairs at its headquarters to include:

Wine name Year of bottling No. of bottles Cost per bottle

I refer also the acknowledgement sent to you on 14 August 2020.

The Department holds a stock of wine for use in relation to State and Official hospitality. The stock facilitates provision of wines suitable for official events at a significant discount from the cost of purchasing them from caterers at the time they are required. In line with expenditure practices overall in the Department, the purchase of new stock is assessed carefully and kept under continuing review to ensure value for money. The average cost per bottle of wine purchased since 2016 is €12.35.

I have identified 1 record that falls within the scope of your request. The record is listed in the schedule attached.
