DIPLOMATIC AND CONSULAR FEES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2017

- I, CHARLES FLANAGAN, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Trade, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 (amended by section 28 of the Passports Act 2008 (No. 4 of 2008)) of the Diplomatic and Consular Officers (Provision of Services) Act 1993 (No. 33 of 1993) (as adapted by the Foreign Affairs (Alteration of Name of Department and Title of Minister) Order 2011 (S.I. No. 246 of 2011)), with the consent of the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform, hereby make the following regulations:
- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Diplomatic and Consular Fees (Amendment) Regulations 2017.
 - 2. These Regulations shall come into operation on 30 March 2017.
- 3. The Diplomatic and Consular Fees Regulations 2013 (S.I. No. 46 of 2013) (amended by the Diplomatic and Consular Fees (Amendment) Regulations 2013 (S.I. No. 119 of 2013)) are amended by the substitution of the text set out in the Schedule for Part 1 of Schedule 2 to those Regulations.
