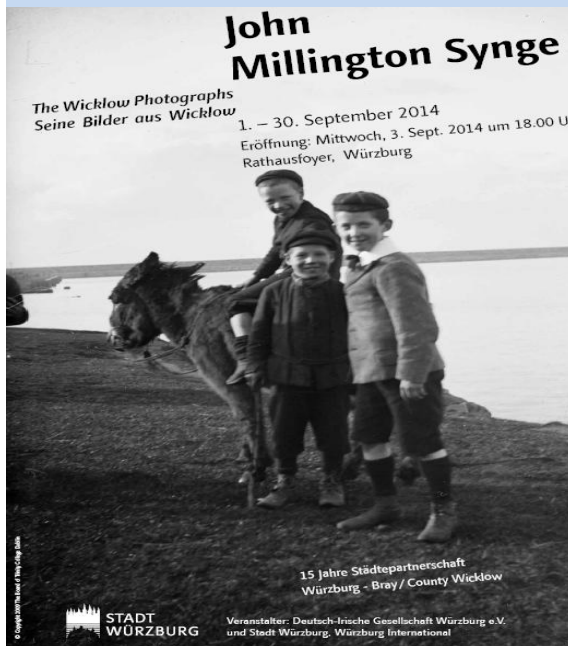

The German-Irish Society of Würzburg and the city of Würzburg are organising an exhibition of John Millington Synge's photographs, taken on his travels in Wicklow. 120 years ago in 1894, John Millington Synge studied for several months at the Royal School of Music in Würzburg. The exhibition will celebrate 15 years of partnership between Würzburg and Bray, Co. Wicklow.

The exhibition will open on 3 September 2014 at 18.00 in the Rathausfoyer, Würzburg, and will run for the whole month of September.

5 September at 18.00: Munich Ceilí Band



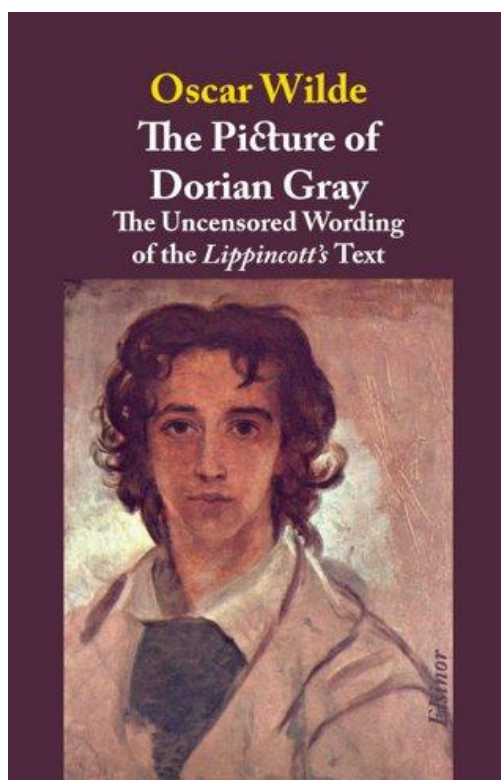

Monday, 8 September at 18.30: Oscar Wilde Exhibition

The exhibition '*Oscar Wilde (1854-1900): A Writer Trapped by His Own Words - A Portrait of the Artist as a Man in Court*' will open at the Embassy of Ireland in Berlin on Monday, 8 September 2014 at 18.30.

The exhibition recounts the story of how Oscar Wilde wrote his only novel *The Picture of Dorian Gray* in the context both of its first publication in 1890 and of his trials in the spring of 1895.

Referring to the typescript for the novel and the first serial publication in *Lippincott's Monthly Magazine* as well as to the writer's literary letters and the transcript of the trial for criminal libel in April 1895, the curator of this exhibition, Dr. Jörg W. Rademacher, shows Wilde primarily as a victim of his own eloquence.

Dr. Rademacher will introduce the exhibition which he conceived in the course of editing and translating *Lippincott's* text of Wilde's novel and Dr. Wolfgang Streit will present Rademacher's edition of *The Picture of Dorian Gray*, published in English and German by Elsinor Verlag.

The evening should provide a fascinating insight into the life and times of a great Irish author and how he wrote and rewrote one of his most famous works.

On Thursday, 11 September 2014, Irish author Peter Murphy will present and read from his debut novel “John the Revelator” at *Europa Literarisch* taking place in the European House (Unter den Linden 78, Berlin). The novel was published by Faber & Faber in the UK and Ireland, and was nominated for the 2011 IMPAC Literary Award and shortlisted for the Costa Book Awards and the Kerry Group Fiction Prize. The German version, “Ich, John” has been published by Suhrkamp/Insel. The evening is jointly organised by the Embassy of Ireland in cooperation with EUNIC Berlin, the European Commission Representation in Germany and the Literaturwerkstatt in Berlin.

This exhibition presents the conceptual work of Irish artist and current lecturer at the National College of Art and Design in Dublin, Sarah Browne. The starting point for Browne's conceptual work is a questioning of everyday objects in terms of their value and their significance within cultural and economic structures. Central to the exhibition is the newly commissioned film of the same name "The Invisible Limb".
