- Science, Technology and Innovation

Please ensure that the form includes: the **area of achievement** under which the nomination is being made; **details of the contribution** made by the nominee to Ireland, Irish communities abroad and Ireland's international reputation; and **two supporting letters**.

The closing date for the receipt of nominations is **Monday 7 May 2018**. The successful nominees will be announced in September 2018. Due to the high calibre of nominations received, all 2017 nominees will be automatically re-nominated for 2018.
